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
2. The appellants pursuant to Section 47 of the *Drainage Act* in attached Schedule "A" shall have until September 5, 2008 to retain counsel, an agent or a representative from among them and provide by September 5, 2008 to the Referee and the Applicant, particulars of their appeal of the Report of T.M. Pridham, P. Eng. dated March 20, 2006, failing which each individual who has filed such appeal and the Memorandum of Appearance shall be bound by paragraph 7 of the Order of the Ontario Drainage Referee dated June 25th, 2008.
3. The following parties described in Schedule "B" are granted status in this proceeding and are entitled to receive notice as ordered by the Referee from time to time during the balance of this proceeding.
4. On September 12, 2008, the Referee will convene a teleconference with counsel described in the Order of June 25, 2008 and counsel, agents or representatives for the parties described in Paragraph 2 of this Order to consider requests for further directions from the Referee, if necessary.
5. All parties described in Schedule "B" to this Order or who remain unrepresented after September 5, 2008 shall provide to the Referee seven (7) clear days notice that they intend to participate in the supply of an Affidavit of Documents, Witness Statements and attendance at and participation in the Examinations for Discovery pursuant to Paragraphs 8 and 9 of the Order of the Referee dated June 25th, 2008.

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6. The Applicant shall serve a copy of this Order by ordinary mail upon all parties who filed a Memorandum of Appearance.
7. The Applicant shall post a copy of this Order on the home page of the website of the Applicant under the heading "latest news" using the heading "Order of the Drainage Referee re: Short and No. 2A Municipal Drains" until September 5, 2008.
8. Costs of the day shall be reserved to the final disposition of this matter.
