The City of Kawartha Lakes is undertaking a design project to fully reconstruct Needham Street between Kawartha Lakes Road 36 and the west limit of Needham Street (approximately 200m west of St. Patrick Street). The works are to include upgrades to the water, sanitary and storm sewers as well as improvements to the roadway which may include curb and gutter and sidewalk. The project is being planned under Schedule A+ of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.

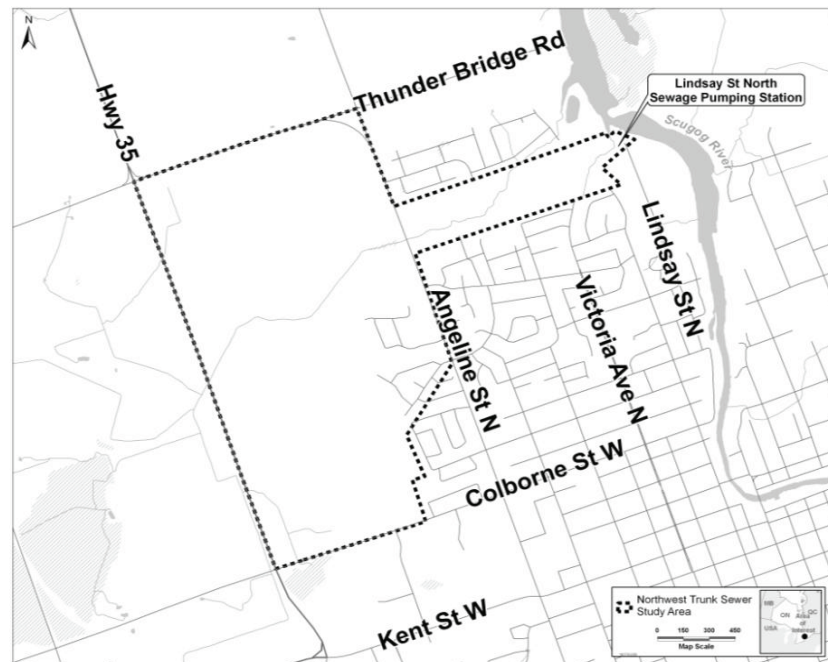

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE REVISED ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT NORTHWEST TRUNK SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION LINDSAY, ONTARIO

#### THE STUDY

The City of Kawartha Lakes has scheduled a Public Information Centre to present the results of the revised environmental assessment and alternative solutions to improve and expand the sanitary sewage capacity in the geographic Town of Lindsay. The City has retained the services of Stantec Consulting Ltd, to study the alternatives available to achieve their objective and recommend a preferred solution.



#### THE PROCESS

This project consists of a Revision to the previously completed and approved **Schedule 'B' Project File** completed by the City in 2000 and modified, by Addendum, in 2003 further to the **Municipal Engineers Association Class Environmental Assessment Act (October 2000 as amended in 2007)** as outlined in the referenced document.

Information regarding the revision to the Schedule 'B' Project File for improving the sanitary servicing, including the proposed alternatives, their evaluation, and the recommended preferred alternative will be presented at a Public Information Centre, scheduled for March 11, 2010. There will be an Open House from 4 to 7 p.m. and a formal presentation from 7:00 pm to 7:30 pm in the Ops Community Centre located on Highway 7, east of Highway 36, Lindsay, Ontario.

Comments regarding the proposed sanitary servicing outlined in the revised Schedule 'B' Project File may be provided at the PIC and will be maintained for reference throughout the project and will become part of the public record. Under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and the *Environmental Assessment Act*, unless otherwise stated in the submission, any personal information such as name, address, telephone number and property location included in a submission will become part of the public record files for this matter and will be released, if requested, to any person.
